<p>Having opened in 1690, The Sunday Market in Kochi City has a long history of over 300 years. This market is the largest in size and has the longest history in Japan. There are 600 open-air stalls in this market which is located along the Otesuji Street. The total length of the market is about one km. The average number of customers in a day is about 40,000. The main goods sold here are local agriculture and fishery products, which are all fresh. This market has prospered as a regular market for local people as well as a sightseeing spot for tourists.</p>
